Data Use Agreement for Summary Statistics Computed in the Michigan Genomics Initiative

The use of summary statistics computed using Michigan Medicine’s Patient Data and biorepository resources for research or quality improvement purposes is a privilege, not a right. With this privilege comes the responsibility to protect the privacy of individuals who are the subjects of the data and/or biospecimens. Investigators external to the University of Michigan requesting summary-level data (e.g., odds ratios and p-values from genome-wide association studies) must safeguard the data by agreeing to not identify or contact the participants nor share or transfer the data beyond individuals supervised by the Principal Investigators listed on this form.
